very human philosophy tries to unravel the mystery of the existence. In this purpose though, they frequently end up falling into closed doctrines, that strive to find a theory completely coherent and capable of explaining the totality of what it is.

Whether we have eaten or not the fruit-of-theforbidden-tree, we are all tangled up de facto in this fine mess: scientists, mystics, religious, philosophers... even politicians, should you ask me!

All of us, one way or another, waddle around this eternal question. And the majority is not even aware of it! Because every thought, consideration or measure to take is and it will always be subsequent to this basic questioning.

All our cosmogony, the bases of our relationship with the Universe, with what surrounds us and inter penetrates us, makes us, influences or determines our life sustaining our realities and our being, will depend on understanding the great mystery of what is Natural and Supernatural.

Is it the invisible natural? Under the position of science, there's no doubt about it! Science, a method of comprehension of everything, researches painstakingly in pursuit of a unique integrating explanation, a coherent theory of the Universe. The paradoxical thing is that the more it strives, the more it falls into contradictory formulas; nevertheless (give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's...), each step it takes is always a milestone in the humanity's consciousness of being, even though those of us who participate in its achievements are always a minority. A minority that far from understanding how they got there, we look forward to the summary of the disseminators, to draw our own conclusions. The funny thing is that despite all the effort of the most thoughtful minds on the planet, the long awaited unified theory of the Universe is still a question rather than a verification. Science, step ahead or behind, bosom up or down, plays between the confused space of energy and matter.

The peoples of the pre-scientific era, more pragmatic than modern scientists (and, it must be said, with modest technical tools) faced these same and eternal questions in antiquity. Instead of looking for a theory in which things fit, they took things and made a theory. All mythology is definitely that, a hotchpotch in which can fit as many gods as necessary.

The natural and the supernatural overlap each other in these conglomerates in view of the layman, but those who delve into the most advanced of these cultures, unexpectedly find an extraordinary coherence behind an apparent chaos. Unexpected ... yes, because we live immersed in an evolutionary optimism, encouraged by the unique and quasi-religious thought that invades us.

How did these cultures overcome the distance and contradictions between a coherent natural order and a distinctive supernatural one? Just as science has discovered that the micro laws acting at the quantum level are not the same as the macro laws, some ancient

peoples, such as the Shizen, discovered that the complexity and nature of the universal forces are enormous and that not all of them are travelling in the same dimensions.


On this plane, they essentially differentiated two sides of what exists: energies and tensions. Both can travel in known or exotic dimensions. They called the first ones TENGU. Nine fractals of the totality of what exists will fit into these patterns. The world of tensions turned out to be much more complex and they called it ONI. TENGU is energy, as Oni speaks to us of tension. With ONI one point addresses another, with which it establishes a rhythmic pattern of frequency. Moving the first one in spiral (Tengu), and the second one in helicoid (ONI), they are the two sides of the same coin, because one feeds the other, despite they are back to back. Their discovery opened for the Shizen the same door that science is opening today towards a unified theory of the Universe.

Within the Universe of the ONI there exist a multiplicity of worlds that were described by the Shizen priests throughout the centuries. Far from trying to give coherence to the whole, they focused on describing their nature in order to deal with them; a titanic achievement of inter dimensional comprehension and communication. Oni exists as waves of conglomerate energies, grouping different frequencies with the specific power of generating concrete events, according to their nature and that of the forces that come together to give them life. These agglomerations of forces follow pre-established patterns, so that once they are known they enter into the Natural.

We call world of the Natural everything that transits within what we consider as known. It is clear that this recital varies greatly from one person to another, as well as from one culture to another. The known is not only describable, but responds to laws. The supernatural necessarily goes beyond all this and we could describe it as everything that transits in the dimension of the unknown, or of the only partially known. Sometimes this plane of what it is, responds to laws other than those of the Natural, because it exists in parallel Universes that eventually interact with our plane of reality, despite they use in this plane the same tools that it provides them; however, these relationships are predictable, since they exist within a mathematical order that can be known and discovered.

There are more dimensions that would be framed within an even more unfathomable and abstruse epigraph and which belong to the plane of what we simply can't get to know. Just as a bi-dimensional being would perceive a sphere that contacted it like a circle that enlarges and shrinks as it travels through its flat dimension, our consciousness of being, when bound to this plane, is unable to even imagine other dimensions, although, as the Shizen priests discovered, it can nevertheless interact with them.

This mediating work between realities was entrusted to the ancient sages and priests, who should be able to jump from one plane of consciousness to another, and







The First Time in History

In the context of traditional martial arts it might be very bold to speak of a "first time in history". Especially since, in my case, we are talking about a 5000 year old martial art and lineage. And yet, it is true. But before we come to the principal point, I would like to give a brief historical account of a great part of history.

any a reader of my articles perhaps already knows that the earliest accounts of the origin of an advanced martial art date back to 5000 years. The monks which are depicted in the old paintings are standing opposite each other in fighting position and are exploring their first complex techniques. The war and martial arts had existed way before the original Shaolin monasteries. The country had been ruled by numerous emperors, dynasties and wars when the martial arts had long been spreading throughout the country, before it then concentrated in the world renowned monasteries. At first in the Northern and after that in the Southern

monastery. The high reputation, the monasteries attracted the best fighters from the whole country. However, the martial arts, which had been taught and perpetually improved there, brought forth enemies, especially from the government. After the destruction of the Northern monastery, the Southern monastery was destroyed as well out of fear of the skills of the Shaolin and the power associated with it. It was destroyed several times. Up to this day, the Southern monastery had to be rebuilt three times because of its enemies who burnt it down.

After the first destruction of the Southern monastery the "concentrated martial art" of Shaolin - or let's just say the Shaolin Kung Fu lost its home. Again the art dispersed throughout the country, just like it had been before it came together from all over the country, but only just the other way round. Everything connected to the term "Shaolin" was prosecuted and punished with death. The last abbot of the then Southern monastery, Abbot Ji Sim Sum See could flee from the destruction and took his best students with him, so that they could carry on the art. Shortly after the destruction and because of the prosecution of the governing authority, Ji Sim's student, Hung Hee Gung, simply called the art "Hung Gar Kung Fu" or translated freely: The Kung Fu of the royal


family. This way the practicing of this art was less dangerous and the prosecution of the new government less likely. Still our ancestors of course had to keep a low profile and went into hiding in the surrounding areas. According to historical accounts, Hung Hee Gung, the best student of the then Shaolin monastery, was, despite everything, a real hero. Thanks to him, the name giver of my style as it is today, the heritage was passed down to Luk Ah Choy, Wong Tai, Wong Kai Ying and finally to the national hero Wong Fei Hung. Unfortunately, apart from their names, there is not much known about the masters from the time between the monastery and Wong Fei Hung. Few facts are known about them, for example that they all were masterful fighters and that some of them were in elite groups in charge of law and order. Up to the time of Wong Fei Hung, the practice of the art from Shaolin was not only allowed, it was even celebrated during the times before that. During this new period of Kung Fu, Wong Fei Hung, one of the most famous of my Kung Fu ancestors, appeared. Wong Fei Hung is not only subject of a folk tale, again and again, but he is also recorded as the character









most played in a film in the Guinness Book of Records. A real hero like everyone in my family. Wong Fei Hung passed on his knowledge to Lam Sai Wing, who is also called "Porky Wing" because of his profession as a butcher. He in turn chose Chiu Kow and his wife as his style successors. Finally, the legacy was carried on by Chiu Kow's and Shiu Ying's youngest son and student, Chiu Chi Ling. Just like many others of my lineage, my teacher, Dr. Chiu Chi Ling, has also achieved greatness and is world-famous. It was already like that when I met him at a seminar when I was in search of THE true master. At that time, there was no internet or other convenient ways to communicate with him, so I tried my luck and travelled to Hong Kong, where Chiu Chi Ling lived in order to ask him to teach me. Of course, he wasn't my first choice. Just like many others today, I was in search of the one teacher back then. I had already gained considerable experience. That was what I thought anyway. Chiu Chi Ling did not object to






giving me lessons, especially since I was standing at his door on that fateful day. I would not have dreamt of the 8 to 10 lessons a day that it involved. As it was common in Shaolin in earlier times, my teacher didn't go easy on me at all, and I guess that's the way it was with any other member of our popular lineage. It often occurred that I simply crashed out in bed after the lessons. I was also taught further lessons outside of the Mo Kwoon ("war room", class room). Just in a very traditional way, he was constantly training me. During the training blocks my teacher would sometimes talk about our lineage and our great history, I was very


fascinated with. I realised there and then, how very well-known the family of my teacher was - even without him telling me all about it. For it often happened that people greeted my master in the streets and even wanted to get an autograph from him or to take pictures. I knew, I had reached the source of real authentic martial arts and I took a decision: He would remain my teacher for the rest of my life.

I didn't need to be motivated to continue to be educated by my teacher. From that moment, my ambition was motivation enough. From then on I formed a habit that



mean for me one day, so I didn't think much of it when my (world famous, unbeatably skilful) teacher had told this to me. I must admit that, at that time, I had no idea what it would mean for me. It was on our way to the airport, when once more I was about to leave my teacher for Switzerland, that I realised what I would inherit. At that revealing moment, Chiu Chi Ling told me during a very short conversation: "I hope you can do it". He said it in a very serious manner while looking straight ahead when we were sitting in the car. "Yes", was all I could

muster at that moment. I realised that my teacher was very serious about it and that I was truly his first choice when it came to, one day, carrying on his reputation, our art, students, schools, and masters associated with it.

Ever since the decision of my teacher I have noticed my changes over the years. Step by step, I was taken behind the scenes of Chiu Chi Ling's organisation. Also, at public appearances, I was obliged to stay close by my teacher's side. For everybody should be informed about who the next successor of this famous lineage

And I am very proud of this and I would like to thank my sifu profusely for the numerous lessons."













THE TECHNICAL STRENGTH OF THE MEIBUKAN



After having done it with Meitatsu Yagi a few years ago, Salvador Herráiz brings us today the figure of his brother Meitetsu, the other son of the legendary Meitoku Yagi (1912-2003), and who today has become the main leader and heir of his father's Karate.

The Yagi family is a descendant of Jana Ueekata Teido, which in turn descended from one of the famous 36 Families that settled in Okinawa in 1392 and brought Chinese culture and Martial Arts to the island. Jana Teido

came to Kume (Okinawa) at the beginning of the 17th century and became a member of the Sanshikan, that is, one of the three Royal Ministers (called Ueekata) of Sho Nei, King of Okinawa. When in 1609 Okinawa was invaded by Japan, the King and the three Ministers were captured and confined in Kagoshima. After two years imprisoned

they were offered liberation in exchange for signing their servitude to the Japanese clan. The King and two of those Ministers agreed, but Jana Teido maintained his convictions and, not having accepted, he was put to death in boiling oil.

Meitoku Yagi (1912-2003) was one of Chojun Miyagi's main disciples, although he was also influenced by Shinko Ko, from Taiwan, and Kobudo's expert from Okinawa, Shinken Taira. In 1986, master Meitoku Yagi was declared "National Living Treasure" by the Government.

As for his son, Meitetsu Yagi, although I had known him for a long time, it was time to learn a little more about him, his thinking and his technique. For this reason, and thanks to the collaboration of his Canadian-born disciple Sean Wong, we made an appointment in Okinawa that started in karategi and ended ... eating tempura sitting on a bench in the park.

I meet him at the Meibukan dojo, in Kume since 1957 (to which I had already gone several times in the past appointed by his brother Meitatsu). Nearby is not only the Fukushu Enn garden (erected in honor of relations with China) but also the shared monument of Kanryo Higaonna and Chojun Miyagi, and the monument to the 36 Families of Kume.

Meitetsu awaits on the stairs, already in his karategi, and after a little conversation we go up to the tatami, on the third floor of the building. There I can check the strength of the master, but also his kindness. Technically, he is ... "Okinawan all the way", a great exponent of that Goju Ryu of the island, where the aesthetic elements, so highly





valued in the West, are left aside to give way to a Karate more motivated by the inner and outer benefits of the practice, and not so much by poses that search an often artificial elegance. Goju Ryu in Okinawa, with a few honorable exceptions, is like that, a Karate externally not so attractive, but full of strength and spirit. Meitetsu Yagi is very strong, even tough in his techniques. I remember his explanations during a seminar in 2009 in which he seemed to have very few friends. Nothing could be further from the truth. He is a hospitable person and he has much desire to please. On the tatami there are several large framed calligraphies. One of them is very important. What does it mean?

"Oku Myo Zai Ren Shin: You cannot get a good level in Karate if you don't have good intentions. Our practice is based on principles such as Tamashii (spirit), Shingi (obligation), Sonkei (respect), Nintai (patience) and Kizuna (goodness)."

After the tatami session, we went down to his house, and while we enjoyed some vital cold drinks to combat the heat and humidity of the island, we talked at length about him, about his life, his opinions and about Karate in general. We see some of my books, which visibly please him. And of course, some of them contain photos depicting him

and the Meibukan Dojo. According to Yagi ... "Karate practitioners must know history carefully. You have to read books and ask questions, although it's often impossible to do everything."

Meitetsu Yagi, was born in 1949, coincidentally on January 1, and started in Karate at the young age of 6 years. At 16 he gets his 1st Dan, not only in Karate but also in Judo. Meitetsu recalls: ""My father woke up very soon me to train. I would have killed him in those moments! Ha, ha, ha... I also trained in the evening... Now I understand and I have done the same with my son."

- What memories do you keep of your father's first dojo, the Daido Dojo?

- "Del Daido dojo I remember that we hardly trained fist techniques. I don't remember a very hard training because I was very young. There was very little light, it was very dark. It's been nearly 60 years."

In 1978, Meitetsu began to teach at the Meibukan dojo and in 1983 he chaired the Nagata's dojo becoming at the same time Director of All Okinawa Karatedo Goju Kai. That same year he traveled to India to teach a course, something that in later years he would repeat in Australia, United States of America and especially Canada, where he has his main group

... that I shouldn't explain here. Meitetsu's nephew, that is, Meitatsu's son, is none other than Akihito Yagi, who has become famous in our world for having starred the excellent film Kuro Obi (Black Belt) with Tetsuya Naka, 7th Dan Shotokan-JKA.


Technical practices at the Meibukan dojo include several types of Yakusoku Kumite (Ippon, Nihon, Bunkai, Renzoku and Kakome), Enbu Kata, Junbi Undo (body strengthening with the typical Hojo Undo materials) and Kumite. "I have also introduced Yakusoku Kumite from the Kururunfa Bunkai Kata and the Shishochin Enbu Kata" - Yagi adds. There are two Kihon Kata: Sanchin and the Sanchin-Tensho combination, both with a strong Ibuki breathing. "San means three, Chin is battle, Ten is turning, rotating, and Sho symbolizes open palms", Master explains.

In Meibukan there are also 10 Kaishu Kata (based on open hand), two of them, Geki Sai Ichi and Geki Sai Ni, come from Chojun Miyagi. Another 8 were brought by Kanryo Higaonna from China, and they are Saifa, Shisochin, Sanseiru, Seisan, Sepai, Seienchin, Kururunfa and Suparinpei. "In Suparinpei we work Nakayubi Ippon

Ken with Nukite. Suparinpei and Pecchurin are the same kata. In fact, both names are written the same except for the first kanji." - explains the Master, who adds - "Then we have Heishu Kata (based on closed hands). Our only Heishu Kata is Tensho, which was developed by Miyagi after coming back from China."


- How important is each technical facet in the Meibukan?

- "I'd say that around 50% is Kata, 20% is practice in pairs and 30% is free fighting. We do practice combat. Strong. We also participate in competitions. We used to do it a lot and now less, but we still do some tournament fighting." In Yagi's dojo, unlike many others on the island, combat is a regular practice. In other dojos they focus their practice exclusively on Kata.
- "It is important goes on the master that every practice be supervised by the master in order to avoid erroneous courses, and you should never betray the master or disappoint him. Unimportant men just talk, they don't listen; those who are more advanced, listen and talk,













but the bigger ones don't talk, they just listen."

- What is your favorite kata?

- "My favorite kata changes according to the moment of my life. Now it's Seienchin. It used to be Sepai, and so were Kururunfa and Suparinpei. It is a question with many possible answers."

Meitoku, Meitetsu's father, perhaps left as the most treasured treasure the five kata Meibuken, Tenshi (Heaven and Earth), and the four protective guardians: Seryu (Blue Dragon), Byako (White Tiger), Shujaku (Red Sparrow) and Genbu (Tortoise). The pairing of the katas Seryu and Byako on the one hand and Shujaku and Genbu on the other, make up a training in pairs.

What do you think of the large number of masters that currently hold the 10th Dan in Okinawa?

- "I think that there are many Karate 10th Dan in Okinawa. Too many, I'd say. But among all the organizations there are four that are the most important, and whose leaders are Minoru Higa, Isamu Arakaki, Kanmei Uechi and me, Meitetsu Yagi. The others are not as big or as important as these."

- What are the differences between old Karate and modern Karate here in Okinawa?

"One of the reasons for the differences in Kata is that, sometimes, masters forgot some parts of the genuine form and then they did it differently. That's why some had a specific version and others had a different one. Also the level of understanding of the various parties is different. But there is no major problem in that. Chojun Miyagi taught different things according to the moment, the era... The height of the withdrawn fist has changed, even the right kick height. We always do Kata the same way, just as they were taught by my father. In my travels I try to make the whole group do the same".

Meitetsu Yagi, faithful to his father's tradition (Master Meitoku Yagi was very fond of music), has also dedicated his talent to the composition of some musical piece, of course dedicated to Okinawan Karate.

- What is Karate for you?

- "Karate is our culture, It's Okinawan culture. It's not only fighting. I have never been involved



in fights outside of my Karate practice. Our ultimate goal is to preserve our culture and improve the world by improving people through Karate. My mission is to preserve Okinawan culture through Karate."

- In your opinion, what are the differences between Okinawan or Japanese karatekas and Western karatekas?

- "In America they don't know about history, lines, teachers... There they change everything and great care must be taken to avoid losing information. Westerners want to train everything. They train different styles or systems. In Okinawa things are not like that. Here each one practices just what he has to practice, what is his, what is due to him. Nothing else."

- Do the various important masters meet regularly in Okinawa?

- "Each one has a different Karate and different Katas. Each one practices only in his group. There is no

relationship among them other than the special events in which demonstrations are made."

One of the added attractions of being with Meitetsu Yagi is the fact that he is the custodian of the karategis that both his father, Meitoku, and Chojun Miyagi himself used at the time. Apparently, Miyagi's karategi had been presented to the master by his disciple Eiichi Miyazato, and donated to Yagi in 1963 by the Miyagi family. In effect, he shows me both garments, which are framed along with their respective belts as real treasures, in the small living room of his house.

During the chat, Meitetsu Yagi pulls out a cigarette and prepares to lit it.

- "Do you mind if I smoke?" - he asks.

- "Oh, no, no. Carry on, you're at home!" I reply a bit sarcastically. He laughs and hurries to explain: "It's true that I shouldn't smoke. But it is also true that with my breathing practices I can clean deeply my interior later."

Now the Master performs some impressive deep





breaths that really seems to remove all internal toxins. Impressive his lbuki breathing, but... I much doubt that it can be sufficient to avoid that the tobacco harmful effects fulfill its negative mission.

Meitetsu Yagi is very hospitable, and that afternoon will be celebrated the neighborhood holiday, Kume, so he invites us to the party. His grandchildren will demonstrate Kata and Kumite. Yagi is very interested in us attending the party and he insists that we should be present, so I tell him that we will, if some other obligations we have in Naha permit so.

When I leave the Meibukan and walk near Fukushu Enn, by randomness of life, I come across in the street with his brother Meitatsu, who, I guess, knows where I'm coming from but ... nothing happens. I greet him politely, it couldn't be otherwise, and we chat just a few

phrases of compliance. Also just a month before had been his birthday and I did not forget to congratulate him, which he thanked me.

In the afternoon, when Master Masahiro Nakamoto, 10th Dan, and his son Mamoru, 8th Dan, leave us in Matsuyama to hang the karategi, after coming together from Shikina Enn in his veteran white Mercedes driven by the Kobudo Hanshi, we head to the Kume party. When Meitetsu Yagi sees us arrive, his face fills with joy and satisfaction and he hurries to entertain us. During the presentation of the Karate demonstration, he even mentions the presence in the party of "a 7th Dan of Karate come from Spain", asking the audience give me a round of applause ... totally undeserved. Just in case it was necessary, and while ritually greeting the public, I get mentally ready to perform a Kata or similar at the request

of the Master, as it already has unexpectedly happened in some other occasion in Okinawa. Not this time.

There we meet his wife, Sueko, who offers traditional Okinawan dances with other dancers. For Meitetsu... "My wife is important to me. Marriage is important. The husband must understand well the character of his wife, and the wife must understand well the character of her husband. It is much more than an external and empty gesture. In this way, a significant contribution is made to society and if the marriage works well it will positively influence the character of the children. A happy marriage is an important part of society and Karate and its teachings can contribute to maintaining family traditions as well."

Meitetsu and Sueko have a son, Ippei, who was born in 1977 and at the age of 6, as happened in the previous generation, started learning Karate with his father, in the dojo of Nagata. Between the years 2001 and 2007 Ippei was Okinawa Champion of Kumite and today he runs the so-called Yagi dojo in the neighborhood of Tsuji, very close to Naminoue. In turn, Ippei's sons, Kohei and Ryuhei, are the great hopes for Meitetsu. In fact, the first thing he did when we saw him in the morning was to proudly introduce to us his grandchildren as Karate champions, who, is obvious, are well instructed also in respect and humility.

At nightfall, and around some drinks, Meitetsu Sensei asks me what time does the plane leave for Tokyo the next day, knowing that my stay on the island is coming to an end. When I tell him what time we will leave the hotel, Yagi rushes to offer to give us a lift to the airport and at his insistence ... I accede. The next day, indeed, at the agreed time, Yagi sensei personally takes us to Naha-kuko with all pleasure, but ... the pleasure has been mine.





Hi. My name is Justo Diéguez. I am the creator and founder of the KEYSI method. The difference between the KEYSI method and other systems is based on values: self-defense begins by valuing yourself, valuing who you are, and then you can start to value who the others are. Self-defense starts when you believe in yourself, when you really feel who you are, when you are really living your inner world, when you are you. It doesn't begin by wanting to be a person with bigger muscles than the rest; or


because you believe to be more than others, or more intelligent; it doesn't even begin because you have different qualities. It begins when you believe in yourself. Fighting is based on intuition, on instinct, not on technicalities.



oreover, aggressors are much more aware of the law and their rights than those who are attacked, who are not used to this, and ready to face these risky and destabilizing situations.

The aggressor is usually a recidivist and knows perfectly the judicial system, while the victim has no idea of the consequences of his actions in his life.

Even if more and more self-defense teachers teach the right of self-defense, and explain the procedures to follow in case of aggression (filing a complaint, not giving too many shots if it is not necessary, etc.), we usually forget that the honest citizen who is confronted with a violent aggression loses all his bearings, and will just try to defend himself with all the means that will come naturally to him.

The huge fear is out of control.

Most of the tips he learned, even if he is a self-defense practitioner, a martial arts practitioner, or a combat sports practitioner, won't be triggered in order to respond proportionally to the attack.

The person who is assaulted will drain off his fear accumulated since the beginning of the attack, by a flood of powerful and uncontrolled strikes.

We can usually witness important damages on the aggressor, after the victim defended himself, and the victim will find himself in an unknown and incomprehensible whirlwind, facing the implacable judicial system.

Indeed, the attacker will file complaints for assault and battery, with all the medical certificates needed.


It may seem insane, but someone who attacks someone else has the right to file a complaint against the person he attacked.


The victim will then face justice and have to explain.


And often, the victim, even if the teachers specify it, will not file a complaint after being assaulted.

Thus, he will be summoned by the police, and will have to answer the accusations of the aggressor, posing as a victim, with evidences of strikes (pictures, medical certificate...).

Even if the police knows perfectly the ones who attack people all the time, they are obliged to summon and take

As a teacher, we wonder how to try to teach to peaceful and honest people how to defend themselves with efficiency to preserve their physical integrity and their own life, without the risk to go to jail or having to pay damages, or both.

We have to be conscious that the techniques taught are made in order to end aggression. But actually, these strikes aim for vital points, endangering the aggressor's life.

However, we also have to be conscious that, without using these violent strikes on vital points, the aggressor, violent and determined, won't stop hitting.

These people don't care about the law, don't respect anybody, but are still protected by the judicial system, which considers as victims any person who has been hit.

Yet, we can't control an aggressor without the use of force if he hit us.

So, the role of the teacher is to tell the truth to their students, by explaining that during an attack, we must leave as soon as possible, if it is possible. And that if we can't avoid it, and the aggressor start hitting us, we will have to respond in order to stay alive, and to stop him.

The most important thing is to protect our life.


We should never hesitate between defending ourselves and risking lawsuits, or taking the risk to die or being seriously wounded, preserving the integrity of someone who doesn't respect anything,

least of us.

But we should not feel invincible by practicing, and pretend to be a superhero by using force systematically during aggression.

As long as we can leave or discuss, we always have to avoid violence, but if it is not possible, we must do everything to stop the aggression and dissuade the aggressor.

This is a real dilemma of every self-respecting teacher who wants to be honest with his student.

Violence and aggression are not a game, but situations like that should not exist, and we must avoid them at every cost.


On the other hand, no one can make attempts to our physical integrity or our life, so we must preserve ourselves and protect ourselves, no matter the consequences.


Respecting the life of others is essential and the basis of all societies, but to respect the lives of others, we must first respect and preserve our own lives.



Siu Nin Tao

Siu Nin Tao is the first form of the Wing Chun Kung Fu system. It is considered the "Cornerstone" of the system and where all the techniques and strategies of the style are sustained. Any Wing Chun practitioner anywhere in the world begins his practice by performing an apparently simple, non-moving form, in which he performs a series of hand movements.

In recent years I've had the immense honor of being able to interview a large number of Wing Chun masters in different parts of the world. The original idea of the project that we develop in TAOWS University was to ask directly many of these Wing Chun referents about the most important elements of the system. Of course, forms, and specifically the SNT form, was a compulsory question to each and every one of them. My intention was that of understanding the motivations and approach of each and every one of them, not to highlights the differences, but quite the opposite, to try to establish the common elements, those that are repeated in all of them. That is, to find what unites practitioners instead of focusing on the differences of each family.

We must try to understand the historical evolution of the style and the "why" of so many changes and differences among lineages and masters, in order to give fair sense to the practice in our days. It's just at this point that the FORMS of the Wing Chun system will serve us good. They will be the witnesses of that historical evolution and they will show us many elements that will surely explain the most important changes throughout the style history. Yes, the STYLE HISTORY.

I believe that a history that is nearly 500 years old deserves the deep respect of all those of us who practice this Kung Fu style. Probably, in the era of the socio-economic globalization, in which everything is measured in economic terms or under the only useful / useless criteria, practicing Kung Fu doesn't make much sense to many. But for some of us who dedicate a few hours of our lives to practicing an ancient style of Chinese fighting, preserving the legacy of our style and bringing it to the next generation surely becomes a "sweet obligation".

I'm firmly convinced that the best way to do that is to study the style in depth and strive to understand its bases so as to make it EVOLVE in its programs and advanced practices.

I am also aware that many of the advocates of the Wing Chun pure tradition don't agree with the term EVOLUTION, but allow me a personal reflection that will surely help you understand my point of view: Evolution is nothing else than ADAPTATION. Yes, pals, adaptation to a changing environment. All the "species" that are not able to accept the constant change of the "ecosystem" and adapt to it disappear through the process of natural selection. Only those capable of such adaptation will improve and create a better future generation.


What is Siu Nin Tao?

Siu Nin Tao is the First Form of the Wing Chun Kung Fu System.

In a system that has only 6 "sets" (there are Chinese styles with more than 80 forms), they all have a great importance within the style. All of them have a purpose or objective, when we try to transfer the information contained in the form to combat or self-defense. But if there is one element that is common to all practitioners, masters or schools / lineages of Wing Chun, is that to the question on the SNT form, they all respond the same: It's the Base, the most important form of the Wing Chun Kung Fu System. EVERYTHING is within the very first form of the system.

It seems logical to think that if everyone attaches so much importance to the SNT form within the system, it must be really important!

I've had the great good fortune of being able to interview the leaders of different lineages of the system and they all agree on this. Everything begins and ends in Siu Nin Tao. And the whole system is contained in the SNT form.

Siu Nin Tao is composed of three words that can be translated quite approximate as

Siu - Small


Nin - Idea


Tao - Form

This tradition is the best known and accepted by a large number of schools, although, in TAOWS University, and after studying in depth the origin of the style, we dare to say that the correct translation should be "Form of Small Ideas". That little detail, the "s" that converts the singular into plural in our language, gives us another example of how "little things" can change the final result of any element.

Siu Nin Tao is the FORM of FORMS in the system. It is the Origin and the End.

Let me explain now this little curiosity so as to try that you, dear reader, become aware of how much information and details hide in the form. For many practitioners of Fotshan (Canton City in southern China, where "Wing Chun Kung Fu" was born), the Siu Nin Tao form is known as Saam Bai Fut, whose approximate translation could be "Pray Three times to the Buddha", in a clear







somewhat contradictory with the way of conceiving in the Chinese mindset

of approximately 100 years ago.

"Numerology" and its relation with the Universe is something that can be mere curiosity for a citizen of the 21st century, but believe me, it was of vital importance for a Chinese of the time. To paraphrase the "I Ching" (The book of change): "... One begets Two, Two begets Three and Three begets the ten thousand Beings..." Referring to the SNT form as Praying Three times to the Buddha is not something coincidental, but the opposite. It's something with a deep meaning for a Chinese of the time. In contrast, the number four has a meaning close to the dead, it's a cursed number (similar to number 13 for many Western citizens). Explaining all this so that the students understand that the transmission of the form through the "fighting songs", often helps us to differentiate the correctness from the whimsical "inventions" of some teachers who try to stand out over other teachers or schools.

Since our main objective is the preservation of Wing Chun Kung Fu, both the "Kuen Kuit" (oral transmission) and the forms are the fundamental elements that allow us to approach a more authentic version and, in this way, try always to protect as best as possible Ng Muei's legacy. That's why


we are so serious about the forms and everything they "hide".







The most beautiful gift that the human being has received from the Universe is the miracle of life. It's so extraordinary that we should all ask ourselves: Why and what are we here for? Are we spirits that fell into our bodies by accident or misfortune?

Personally I do not believe in accidents, everything has a balance. Hundreds of generations must've passed so that we could be here today, and this will keep happening just the same in future generations. We are spirits in bodies, but also bodies with spirit.

Why I do what I do?

Because it's like breathing, like walking. Because doing what I do, I don't pretend, I transform myself and I am free.

I had never dedicated so much time and effort to anything. Now, from a distance and with a perspective, I can see that such dedication marked a pre and a post in my life; "Rodamundo", a job that covers all the areas in which you can defend yourself in a melee, was born from this experience, and most probably, had it not been for all that time, effort

and dedication, the Keysi method wouldn't exist today.

Doing what I did showed me the path I should follow. That enthusiasm and dedication has led me to meet and find a lot of friends from around the world. And when we are together we feel that rhythm, the rhythm of our hearts in each of our movements. It seems stupid but all of us who feel this rhythm are connected to a way of life.

Fortunately, there are the memories of why you do what you do and why you did what you did, and all that process is the consequence of who we are and why we are here today. 

Traditional arts and perfectionism

Living within rigorous traditional regimes, mainly linked to extreme discipline and obedience, requires an intense exercise of self-control and energetic-emotional balance.

In the history of Japan and the Orient in general, we can observe a union of opposing activities that were practiced by ancient masters, with the aim of keeping the spirit in a state of peace and harmony.

Despite they were in possession of a great martial knowledge, masters of old sought a counterpoint in arts that elevated the spirit to evolution, such as the chá-no-yu or tea ceremony, meditation, bonsai, calligraphy, sumi-e (Japanese classical painting that uses coal), and even religious principles that mitigated frustrations and rebalanced human feelings. In that aspect, many clans in Japan had a religion that they practiced, like Shintoism or Buddhism, to lead man to another perspective of existence.

With the passing of the years and the expansion of the oriental arts toward the West, although traditions were maintained in many aspects, the occidental way of thinking brought about a system of adaptation of these arts to the life rhythm and the vision of the West, a very broad topic which will be discussed another time.

In the history of Martial Arts that came to the West, we can sometimes find points of mutation of techniques and styles, as well as the reasons why other new arts were created. It is the network of natural influence of our millennium.





As long as these arts were kept exclusively within the range of their culture of origin, in which they were scarcely altered by the ways in which they were practiced, due to the features of the families that maintained them, their essence remained intact.


However, the West had a less rigid way of thinking and behaving, especially compared to Japan. The characteristic way of acting and living of the Japanese people, differs significantly from other eastern countries, and thus, in a comparative analysis with the West, Japanese culture in its more primary form of discipline, collided with the mindset and the way of thinking of all the foreigners who got to know Japan in the summit of the Samurai statute.

The arts of war that came from that epoch were naturally loaded with the principles of martial practices in their highest degree of physical and disciplinary demand. The pursuit of technical perfection and the maintenance of a tradition imposed on those who would represent the heritage of knowledge, an incessant perfectionism along with the concern of the fulfillment of their mission or karma of elevating the art itself.

But how to survive an exaggerated perfectionism?

Perfectionism is usually defined as a "depressive syndrome, derived from frustrations and failures that decompensate the person". The perfectionist person presents a rigid formation, which prevents him or her from adapting to different situations. It lies within the personality of the perfectionist and it can be confused with the obsessive-compulsive disorder and receive a wrong treatment.

But the big difference between them is that the obsessive-compulsive person has an idea that considers absurd, irrational and that causes tension. Therefore, it must be performed as a ritual, that is, presenting a compulsive behavior. Obsession leaves the person without will. While the perfectionist always tries to do the job in the best possible way, and he's never satisfied with the result





American psychologist, Monica Ramirez Basco, in her book "Never Good Enough: Freeing Yourself from the Chain of Perfectionism", identifies two types of perfectionists:

- 1. Introspective: They show little self-esteem and confidence. They feel that any mistake will be terrible and that if they made a mistake they wouldn't have the affection and approval of others. They are never satisfied with themselves.
- 2. Extrospectives: They don't present low self-esteem, but they don't trust in the skills or capacities of the rest of the workgroup and so they don't manage to delegate. They demand from people the perfection they seek in themselves.

Perfectionist persons expects everyone around them to be perfect and it annoys them if they fail to apply discipline rules to the others. The people they live with, don't know their expectations, which causes tension with their family, friends and colleagues, and a great feeling of anger. The key is to understand that it isn't possible to force other people to have perfectionist attitudes.

The individual with a perfectionist personality can change his behavior little by little and successfully. He must learn to prioritize his activities, without doing everything in an extremely perfect way, since that is what makes him lose sight of the main objective of his actions.

For a martial practitioner, or even for any athlete, not reaching the degree of expectation generated on himself, can be an aggravation of perfectionism, guilt and selfpunishment.

In the history of mankind, guilt is a feeling that causes self-hatred and with it self-punishment and emotional imbalance. That happens because it usually stems from a demand, something that we don't want to do and that leads us to submission. Guilt is the most effective method of making a person submit to the whims or desires of another person. That feeling was refined and used in the Middle Ages by many religions, who first fantasized about guilt so as to hit people inside, and then claimed to have the elixir of forgiveness or salvation, often leaving the feeling of faith on the background.

The feeling of guilt was also perfected in the family environment and many parents have used this method to guide their children, educating them through emotional blackmail: "... if you confess that you are guilty, I forgive you".

Since guilt is a feeling that doesn't arise in us, it must be implanted by another person and contracted as a disease. The more suggestible or naive the victim, the greater the

power of self-destruction. As it's being cultivated, the sense of guilt is creating a greater dependence on the one that receives it, increasing internal unrest and, consequently, greater submission.

When we don't do anything that we'd like to have done or might have done, we feel a kind of disappointment that suddenly imposes itself. We call it remorse. But when we are demanded to do something that we simply don't want to do and neither have the capacity nor the vocation to do it, and for a phony understanding we demand that of ourselves, the guilt of not being able to do it falls to us like a condemnation.

Each person has his or her own ideals, limits, vocation ... Formerly, it was common that when the children didn't behave as expected from them and parents did not obtain praiseworthy results, the father or the mother, or both, tried to raise a guilt feeling by using psychological techniques like: "God will punish you...", "That's a sin...", "I'll die out of grief...", or punishing them with threats of lack of love or protection, mixing feelings and thus creating a confusion of ideas and logic reasoning, through emotional distress.

As "culprits" got increasingly frustrated for not being able to get rid of that feeling, they became more and more submissive, increasing their guilt complex and nullifying their own Self. Consequently, they acquired a robotized or eternally revolted personality.

Being forced to go through those moments, these people ended up by blaming themselves, acquiring an incurable hereditary disease, and carrying that feeling even in adulthood, besides transmitting it, unconsciously, to their descendants.

From the psychological point of view, there are natural and physiological emotions that appear in every person with an important biological substrate, such as joy, fear, anxiety or anger, among others. These emotions, which are pleasant or unpleasant, mobilize us to activity and take part in interpersonal communication. Therefore, those

of personality and the previous experiences of life, would represent the core of that evaluation system.

Since the 1960s, Selye has been saying that the "preference" of a stressor for a particular organ or system, as well as the intensity of that response, seems to be determined by internal and external conditioning factors, that is, it depends on inherited and acquired features.

According to this extremely personal aspect of the subject's response to stress, we can understand that in similar situations, the various individuals will react differently. This will always reflect the peculiar way in which each one assesses situations, and so, what is stressful for one, may not be for another.

In the same way, also the way of facing each situation is peculiar and particular to that determined individual, according to his history, circumstances, aptitudes and personality. These personal aptitudes (of his personality) are those that offer us greater or lesser "options" to confront the situation. And the word "options" goes in quotes because it's an intentional and involuntary attitude. It can be said then that the most elaborate option of confrontation would be to face the situation in a conscious

and objective way, being able to talk about it, discuss and weigh, surpassing it according to the characteristics and resources at our disposal.

When approaching the situation in an objective way isn't possible, either because the problem is not clearly understood or because the resources available to the personality are lacking, the tendency will be to resort to other more atypical forms of confrontation.

A mental way of facing a serious situation would be, for example, fantasizing, rationalizing, denying, praying. The emotional way of confrontation would be depressing, attacking, blaming others or blaming oneself, crying, screaming... There are also some atypical confrontation attitudes which would be isolating, exhibiting, joking, taking risks, eating, drinking, making love, smoking, working excessively and finally, of particular interest to psychosomatics, a somatic form of confrontation, represented by getting sick.

In order to understand more clearly the processes of somatization, we must consider, above all, the types of emotional response resulting from our assessment of reality (and from stressors) and our personal and particular

mechanisms of confrontation of the situation. The somatic choice for the hatching of emotions seems to depend on a series of factors or mechanisms, from the most somatic to the very psychic.

Observing animals and people, we notice the presence of two components in the subject's emotional process of adaptation to the demands of reality. There is the expressive component or indicator and the behavioral or confrontational component, properly speaking.

The physiological and / or somatic manifestations resulting from adaptive stress, called somatizations, can be understood as a way of speaking or expressing oneself. And the less efficient the mental or cognitive mechanisms of feeling, speaking and acting, the more the somatic system will be used to express emotions. This means that the more "pure" emotions are, the less somatic they will become.



A good training, whether traditional or not, is the one that shows us that we should take advantage of every moment of our lives to improve our attitudes without fear of someone blaming us, without fear of being selfish, but because that leads to individual progress and, therefore, to collective development.






Jim Wagner Security and Combat

In last month's issue we explored the O.O.D.A. process (observe, orient, decide, act), which are the four steps of a pattern that every human brain follows in sequential order whenever faced with a combat situation, be it on the streets, in a self-defense situation or even in a Martial Arts school.







n this issue we will take our understanding a step further and learn what happens to us psychologically and physically, before, during and after a fight. This process, which is well understood and taught to the police and military, is called the Assault Cycle. Like the O.O.D.A. process, the mind and body will follow a distinct pattern no matter what the combat experience. By understanding this process, you will become a better fighter.

There are five events which will always occurs in any combat situation, and these five elements will always follow the same order. How much time that is spent in any one phase depends on the circumstances, and how you

will cope with it. The five phases are: the triggering event, escalation, crisis, recovery, and post-crisis.

The Psychology of Combat: Part II The Assault Cycle Triggering event

Just prior to a fight something will alert you to the fact that it is immanent. It could be a gradual build-up where you see someone enter a movie theater holding a knife, or it can be instantaneous, such as somebody jumping you from behind and you catch the sounds of footsteps.





Reality Based


As a police officer, I typically experience several triggering events the nights when out on patrol. Most of the time I am able to diffuse the situation before it goes to the next phase. However, there are times when physical conflict erupts and I have no choice but to use force. Because the average police officer experiences this phenomenon often, they tend to be calmer and more analytical in the face of danger, whereas most martial artists tend to over react in many "triggering" events. Why? Because every time traditional martial arts students are in front of their fellow student in training, they engage in fighting


techniques. Yes, it is important to practice your fighting skills, but it is equally important to have situational training where some conflicts do not always end in physical force. This is where good scenario training comes in.

Escalation

Like the triggering event, escalation can occur instantly, such as a terrorist taking over an airplane running up and down the aisles. Escalation can also occur over a period of time, like when someone is







following you home and you know something is wrong.


A good example of escalation would be if you are at a restaurant and you hear two obnoxious drunken men at the table next to you. This is the triggering event. But, as soon as you look over at them and one of them yells at you, "Mind your own ##!!@! business!" the situation has just escalated. At this point there will be certain psychophysiological events that will begin to happen in your mind and body: your heart and breathing rate will increase, you will intently focus on the threat

(known as tunnel vision), and you may get sweaty or nervous, angry or scared, and you will definitely decide what you should do - fight, run away, or submit.

Again, good scenario training (acting), as part of your routine workout, will help you learn to stay in control during the escalation phase of an assault. The more you practice the better you will be at appearing calm, at controlling your breathing, and you'll learn to make good tactical decisions.




Recovery


This is the phase just after the crisis. It does not necessarily mean that the fight is completely over, although it could be, it just means that the immediate threat is over. Therefore, during this phase you must "pull yourself together" and think about treating injuries, getting help, or getting into a safer area. It all depends on the situation.

The problem with most martial arts training is that they learn how to fight, but they don't cover what to do once the fight is over. To my own students, I'll come up to one of them immediately after they have just finished sparring and say, "You have a broken arm! Start treating it now!" or "The criminal just ran off! Get on the phone, call the police and give them a description and the direction he is heading!" This kind of training













reminds them of the recovery phase, and that there is still work to be done.

Post-crisis

This is the phase where you are completely out of danger, and now you have time to finally recover and reflect. This is a time when physical and mental fatigue set in. The body and mind seek to return to a normal condition known as homeostatic stability (stability within a social group). Emotions can range anywhere from euphoria (having survived) to severe depression (guilt, injuries, etc.), and its severity will depend upon how traumatic the conflict was.

Anytime somebody has gone through a very violent crisis, it is always best for that person to talk to someone – whether to a professional or a close friend. Just talking with someone can relieve emotional pressures, and it gives the person assisting an opportunity to help the victim get back to a normal base level.

"Yes, it is important to practice your fighting skills, but it is equally important to have situational training where some conflicts do not always end in physical force."

"Therefore, complicated or fancy techniques that are easy to do in the training hall are ineffective in the street due to adrenaline, fear, and survival instincts."
